Instructions for Contributors

Categories of Papers

- This journal accepts three categories of papers : articles, short notes and book reviews.
- 2. Articles should be not more than 12,000 words, short notes, not more than 1,500 words, and book reviews, not more than 3,000 words. Authors wishing to submit a paper longer than 12,000 words (including notes, references, appendices, and illustrations) should consult with the editors in advance.

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- Manuscripts must be typewritten in English, French or German using white paper of A4 size (210×297 mm) or letter-size (8.5"×11"), and must be double spaced throughout (24 lines per page), including the text, figure captions, notes, appendices, and references. Margins of at least 3 cm must be kept on all edges of the page. Manuscripts should be printed in a standard font such as Times Roman, in 12 point or larger type.
